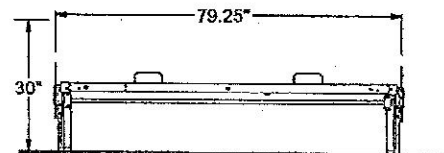

SIDE VIEW - FOLDED



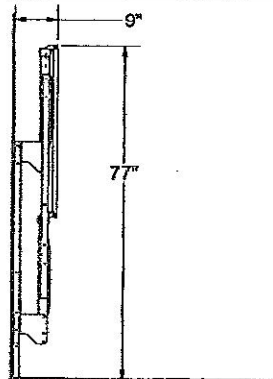
SIDE VIEW - UNFOLDED



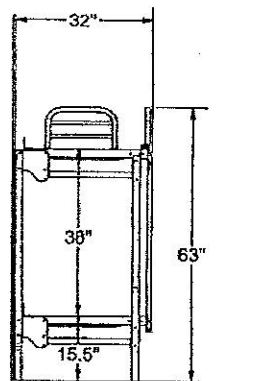

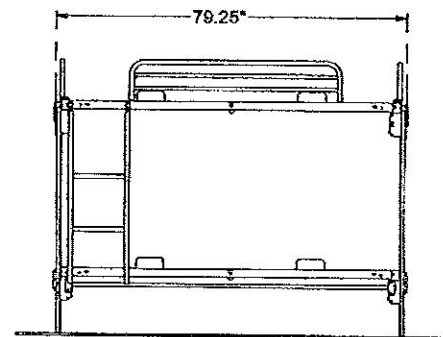

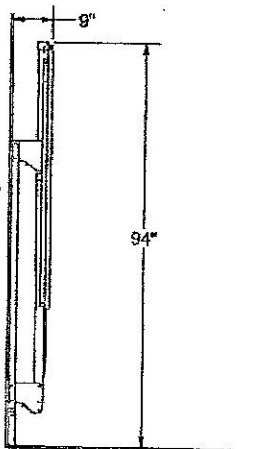

SAFETY WARNINGS

Patent Pending

This wall mounted foldable bunk bed is designed to give many years of comfortable and safe use by following these simple instructions:

- Wall blocking for screw attachment is required and should be at least 1 1/2 (38 mm) inches thick hardwood securely fastened to at least two wall studs on each side within or on the surface of the wall. See page 2 for locations.
- It is recommended that two people perform the assembly of this bed.
- Optional wall brackets are provided that allow the bed to be removed from the wall. Those beds must be removed while they are in the stored and secured position. Any disassembly must be done with the beds folded flat. This will ensure that the lifting springs are in a position that eliminates potential for injury.
- Only adults should raise and lower the beds.
- Keep hands and fingers away from all moving parts while raising and lowering.
- Never raise the bed to the stored position with someone in it as this could cause serious injury or death.
- Always secure the beds with the tie-down straps when in the stored position to prevent accidental lowering.
- Follow the information on the warning label appearing on the upper bunk end and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.
- Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in. (127mm) below the upper edge of guardrails.
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
- Periodically check and ensure that the guardrails, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
- Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
- Always use guardrails on the upper bunk.
- The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.
- **STRANGULATION HAZARD** – Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts and jump ropes.

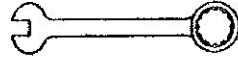

OPERATION

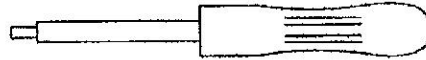
TO LOWER THE BEDS TO THE FLOOR: First release the tie-down straps on each side. Then while supporting the bed frame with one hand, grasp the cross tube at the center with the other hand and pull to release, then gently lower the beds to the floor and unfold the safety rails.

TO RAISE THE BEDS TO THE STORED POSITION: First lift the top bunk mattress and fold down the safety rails. Grasp the front rail of the lower bunk and lift slowly until the beds are flat against the wall. Now secure the tie-down straps around the legs.

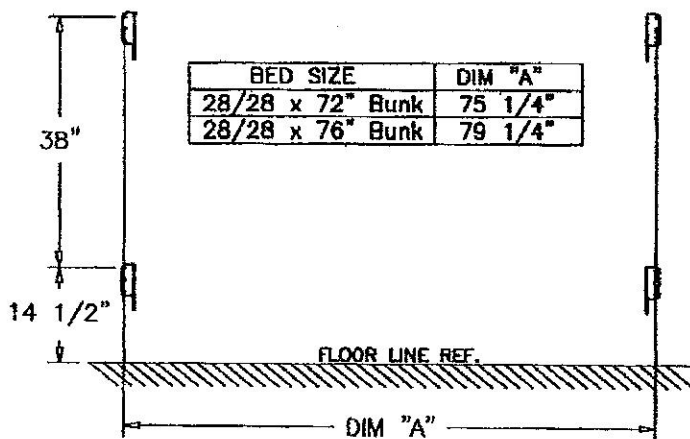

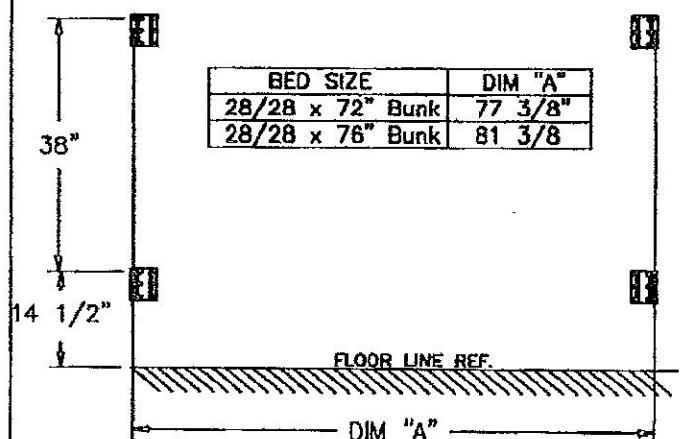

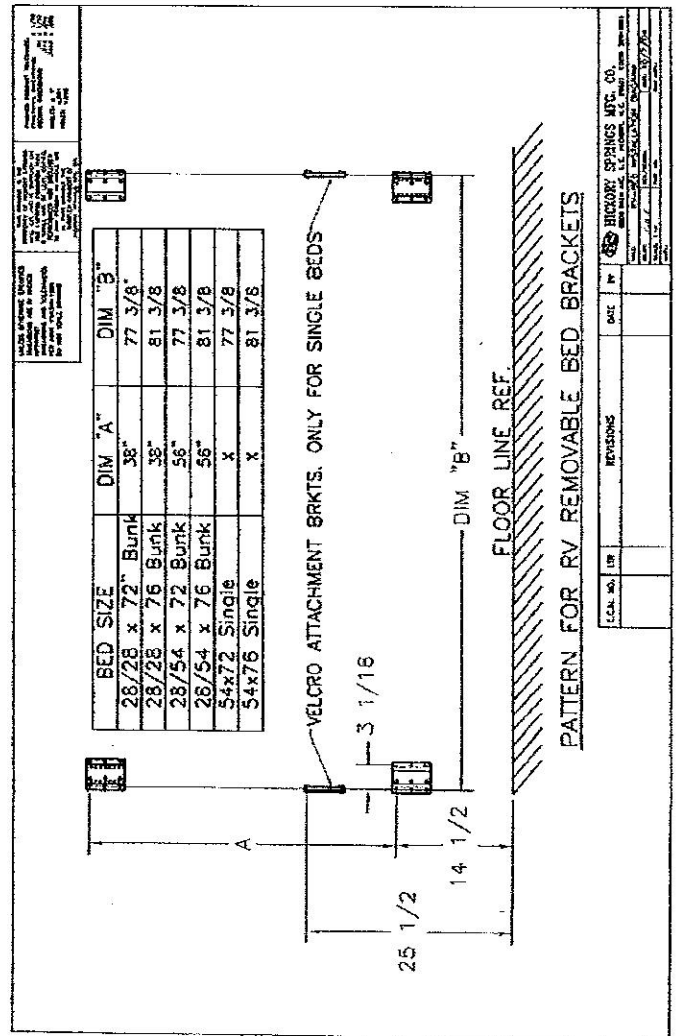
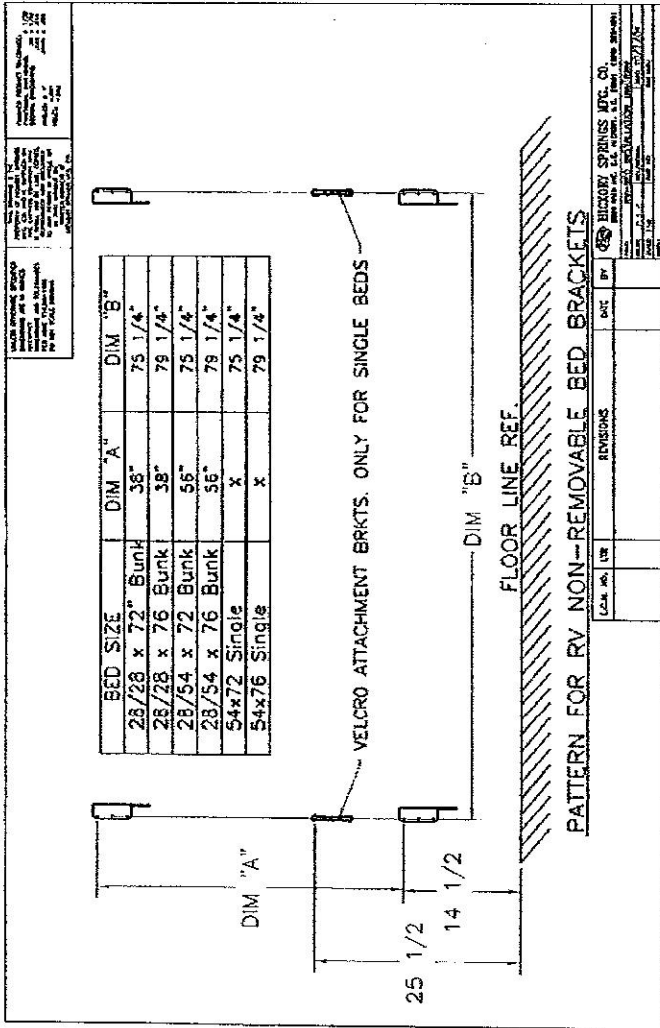
SCREW LOCATIONS FOR WALL BLOCKING

PATTERN FOR PERMANENTLY ATTACHED BED

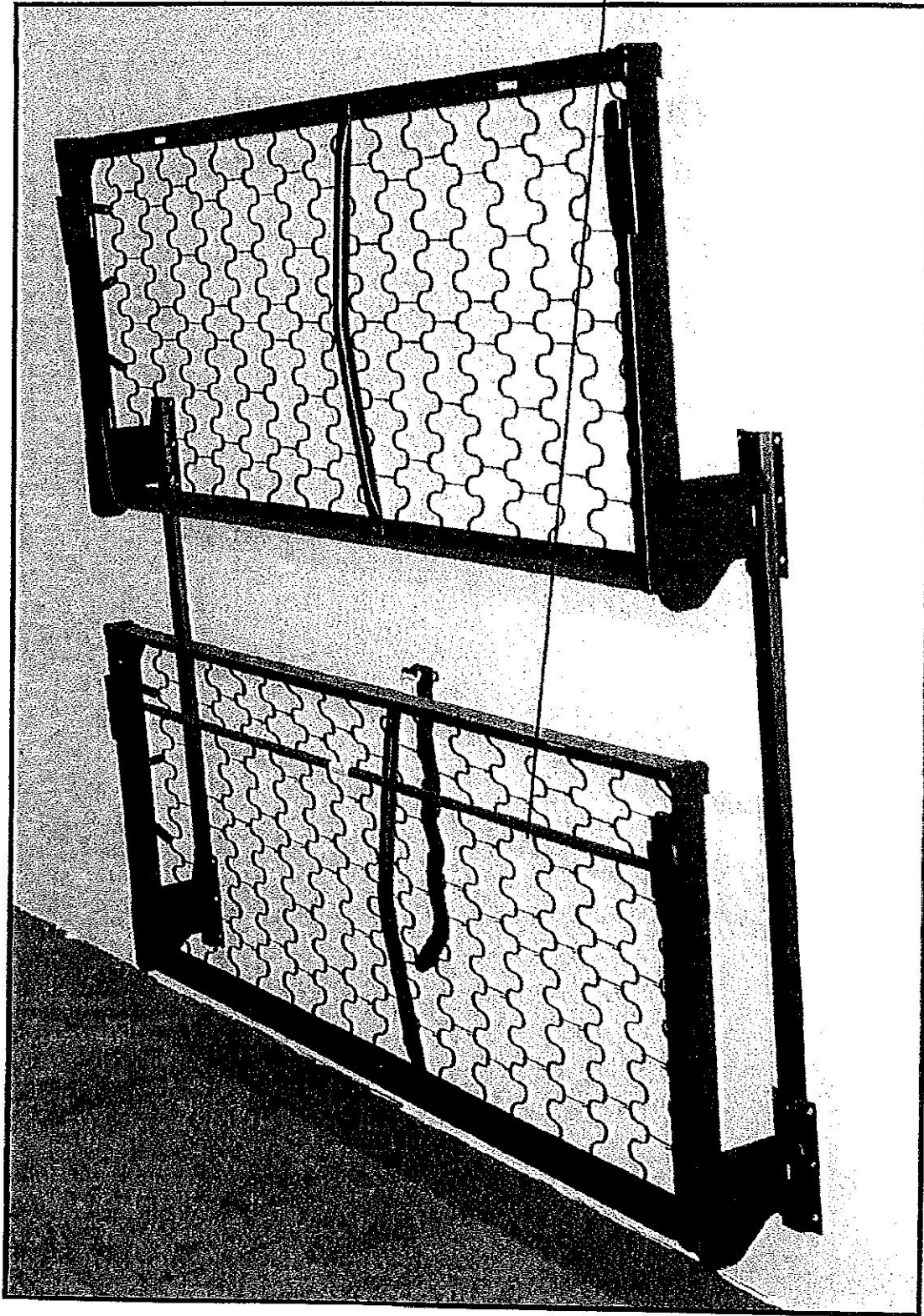


PATTERN FOR REMOVABLE BED



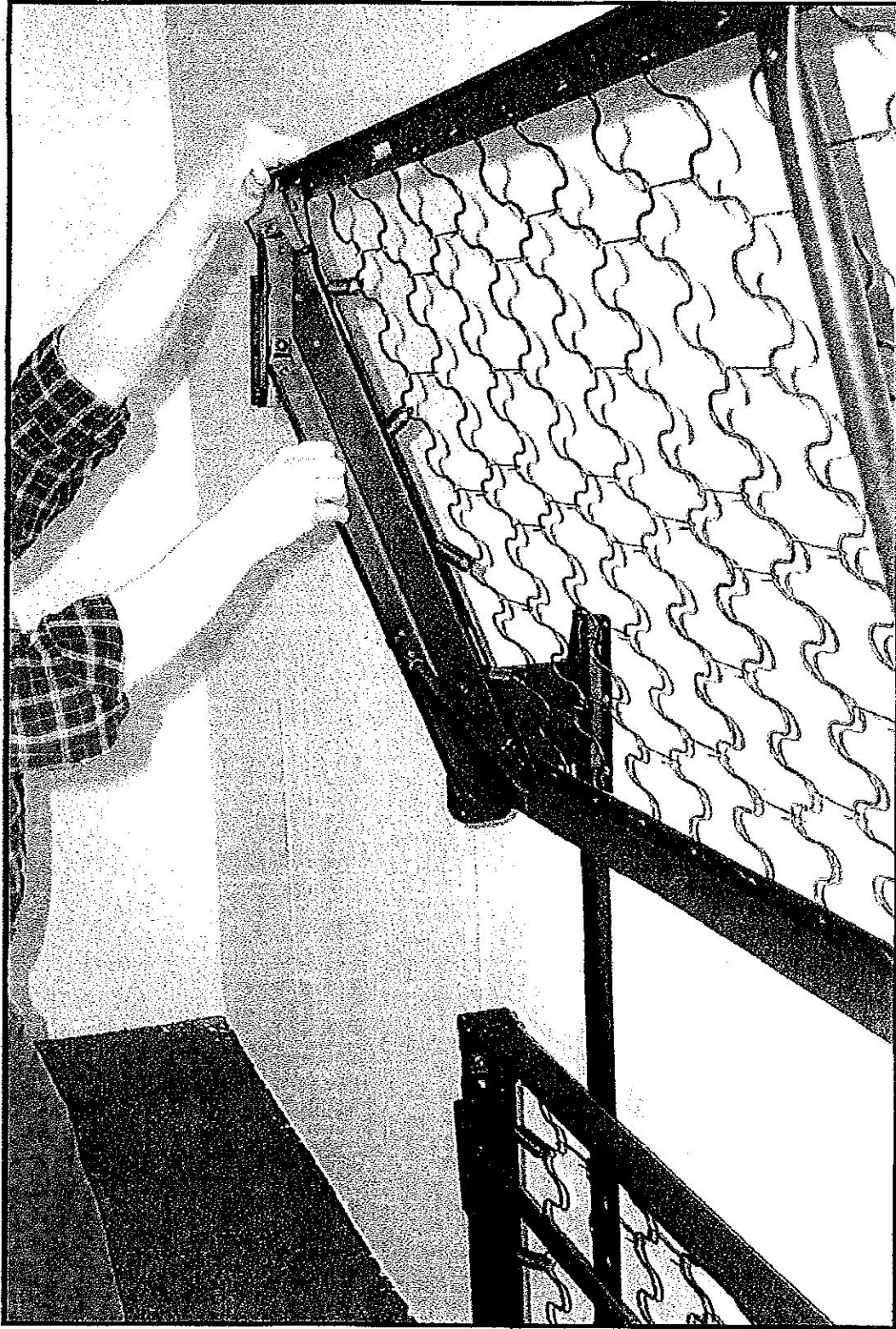


NOTE: THE BOTTOM BUNK HAS THE CROSS TUBE



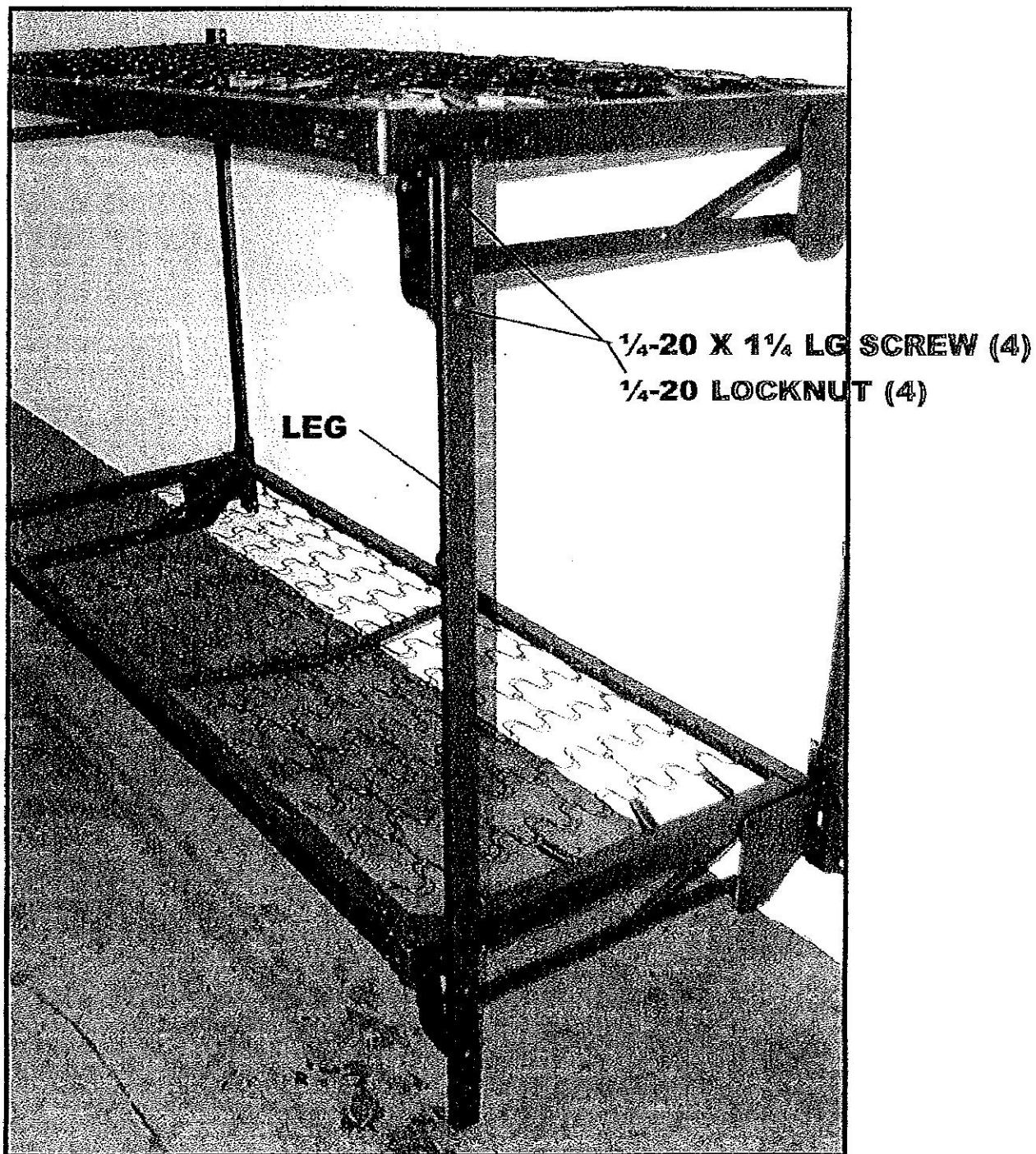
BED FRAME INSTALLATION

WITHOUT THE LEGS BEING ATTACHED**

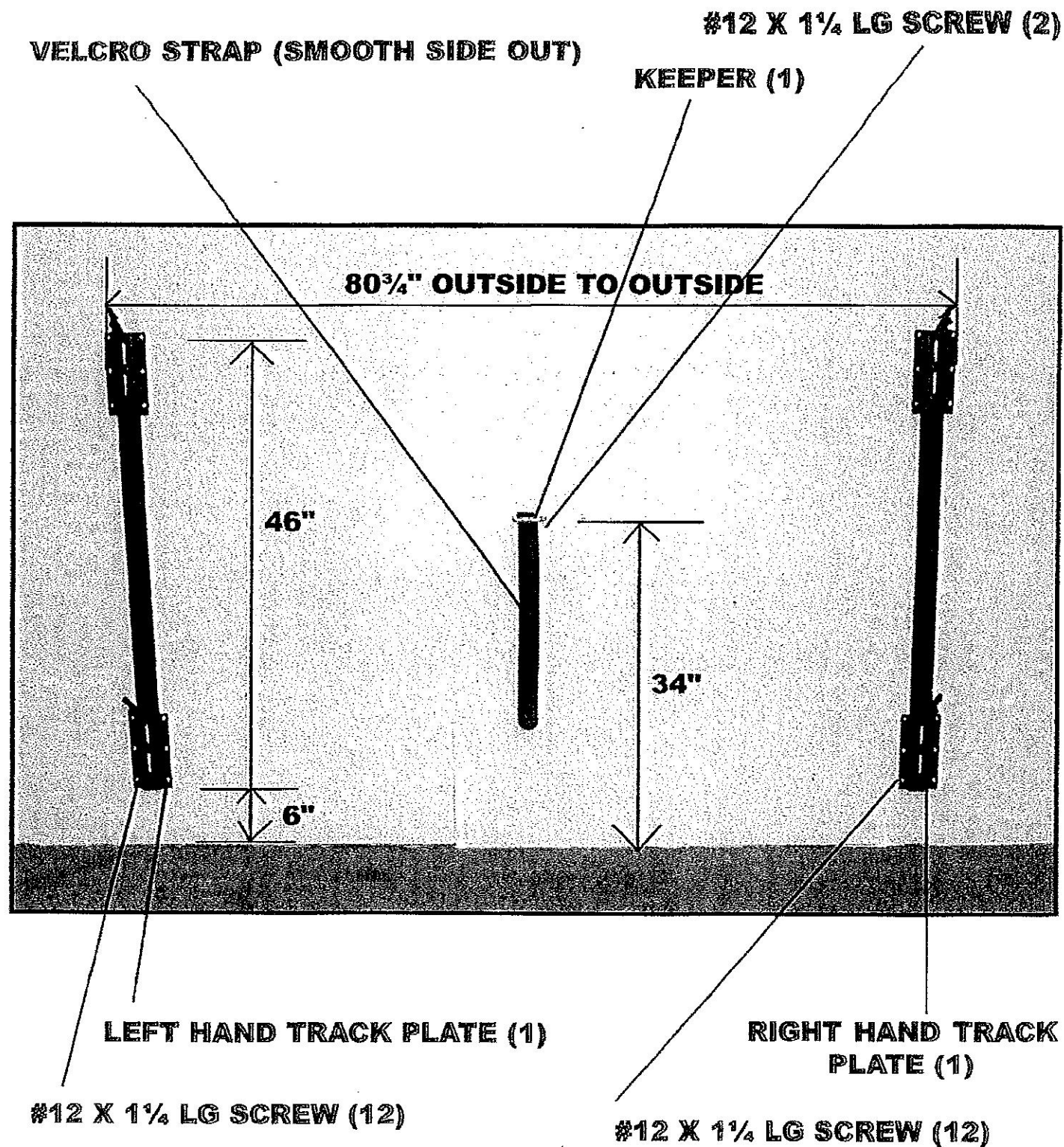


LOWERING THE TOP BUNK

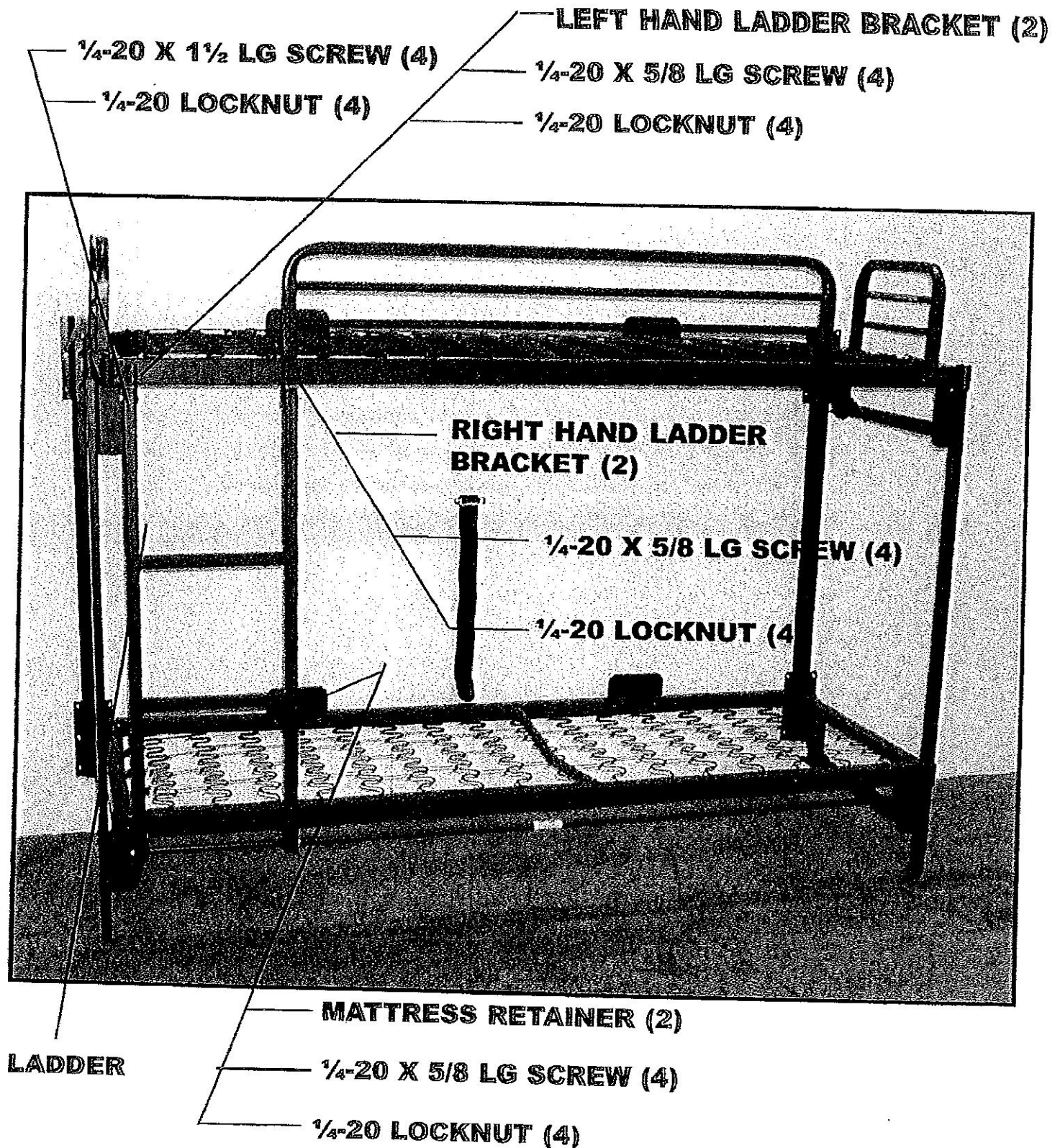
